Always seek to meet the seller/owner at their home address. If this is not offered then be suspicious. It is preferred not to meet at car parks or alternative locations. It is also always better to view a vehicle in daylight.

Make sure you see the Vehicle Ownership and Registration Papers – take a copy. Use your phone to take a copy if necessary. Ask the seller to provide separate ID (i.e. Drivers Licence) and make sure the sellers ID and address match the Registration Details.

Take photos of the vehicle from all angles – including the interior, under bonnet and the instrument display. Make sure you ask questions – for example:

- How long have you owned the vehicle?
- Why are you selling the vehicle?
- Has the vehicle ever been involved in an accident?
- Does the vehicle have any finance owing?
- What modifications have been made to the vehicle?
- Who did the vehicle modifications?
- Are receipts or evidence available for the cost and payment of modifications?
- Are the modifications street legal?

Before agreeing to purchase any vehicle always make sure you conduct an on-line PPSR Search.

A PPSR Search is very important. It will show if money is owing against the vehicle plus it will show if the vehicle has ever been a “Repairable Write-Off”. The cost is very low and may save you \$000’s.

Be careful if a vehicle is classified as a “Repairable Write-Off”. These vehicles generally cannot be financed or compressively insured.

We always recommend you obtain a full independent mechanical inspection from a qualified/licenced technician. These mechanical inspections are generally low cost compared to large mechanical expenses later.
